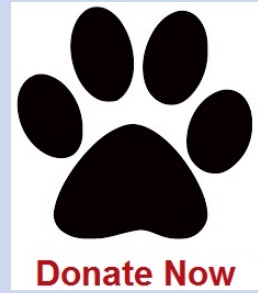

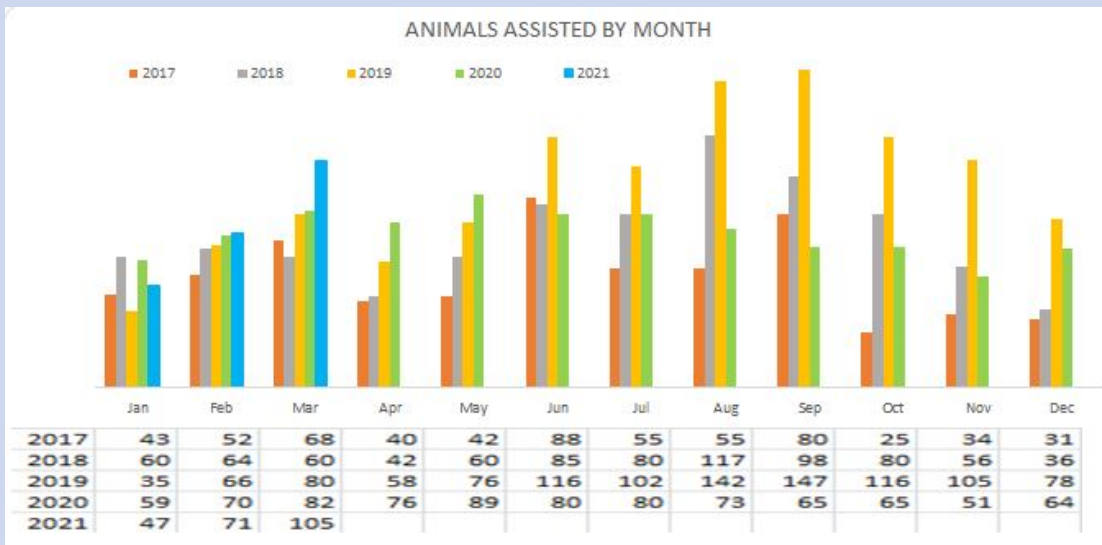


Spring is in the air!

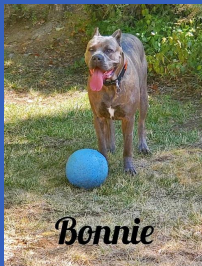

Bonnie's owner contacted us to inquire about our low-cost spay neuter program. Weighing in at 111 lbs, and being a female, [Read more...](#)



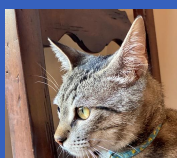
Logan

Here is a list that may help you make the right decision for your pet. Some we are sure you already know, but some may surprise you:

Sure – Rice, lettuce, bananas, carrots, pears, cantaloupe, spinach, fish, pumpkin, meat, peanut butter.

In moderation – hot dogs, pineapple, bread, apples, strawberries, blueberries, tomatoes, cheese, watermelon, potatoes, broccoli, mushrooms.

Not recommended – cherries, peppers, corn, marshmallows, popcorn, shrimp, almonds, celery.

Nope – Onions, walnuts, beer, pomegranate, chocolate, nuts, garlic, gum, grapes, avocado.
