This boutique has brought in more than \$300K since 1995 when Jackie Barnett started this endeavor. Since that time, we have provided financial assistance to thousands of community animals getting them the medical help they needed.

Volunteering

VolunteerMatch recently partnered with UnitedHealth Care on a study to gauge the impact of volunteering on health aimed at inspiring a new level of service and volunteerism in communities across the country. Dubbed "The Doing Good is Good For You Study," the study found:

- 75% of U.S. adults feel physically healthier by volunteering,
- 88% report increased self-esteem by giving back, and
- 93% report an improved mood.

- Medical Care Case Assistant coordinate with the care giver whose animal needs medical treatment and the veterinary office providing the service to ensure urgent medical care needs are met.


